# Etiquette Of Reaching Out



Under no circumstances should you be rude or make yourself look negative- this will hurt your job prospects and opportunities

As one of my professors always say, "The industry is small! Everyone knows each other, word gets around. Don't ever create a negative image for yourself."

- The most important rule EVER: Do NOT **EVER** reach out to someone with a demanding or arrogant tone.
- Act online how you would in person.

  Building a relationship or connection is a two-way street. It's about give and take-being polite, kind and interested will go a long way.
- → Never start talking with someone with the assumption or goal to receive something in return such as a job.

Sometimes the knowledge or information someone gives you is much more valuable.

# Etiquette Of Reaching Out



If you're still a student, see your advisor or career advisor to receive tips on your resume and other professional pieces of your arsenal. Starting with a solid resume, website, and other business information is key.

Connect with alumni and classmates that intern or work at companies you're interested in.

★ Find out their experiences and learn about their journey!


- Attend company/industry/school events!
  - Find club's hosting speakers!
  - Companies hosting talks or special demonstrations
  - Recruiting sessions
  - o Etc.
- ★ Introduce yourself! (Who are you? What do you do? Where do you study or work?)
  - What are you hoping to gain from to conversation? (Looking to learn more about who your speaking to? More about a company or job position? About an opportunity or mentorship? Requesting for some feedback on your work or resume? Etc.)
  - Would they be willing to speak about it over messaging, virtual chatting/meetings or in person?
  - Thank them! (They took the time to read and possibly respond to your message! Many people are incredibly busy, be polite!)

# Do your research before you reach out!

#### Don't be a stalker-just do your homework.

- → Research people you want to connect with
  - Career History
  - Project History
  - Where they currently work and their position
  - Research their current company's history & active projects
- → Research Companies you're interested in
  - Learn about company culture
  - Learn about what company's offer
  - Learn about company resources & locations
  - Learn about their projects and jobs/internships



#### What to talk about

- Introduce yourself first of all. Who are you and why did you reach out?
- → Ask them career or life questions.
- Discuss industry/job/company related topics.
- → Ask for questions about software/topics.
- Ask if they would be open to reviewing your resume or website!
- → Ask if they have any advice!

- Politics
- → Religion
- Negative speech about a person, company or coworker
- Going around begging/asking for jobs and opportunities

#### **Tips**

- Not everyone accepts your connection!
- Not everyone responds at all or in a timely manner. Be polite & respectful, if you really want a response try to follow up in a week or two.
- Don't be rude or ask for a job flat out. Build something meaningful-don't use someone.
